



Knitted and Crocheted Baby Blankets

Baby blankets can be made from cotton or acrylic yarn (NO wool.) Light colored baby yarn is nice but other types can be used as well. The size should be approximately 30x30 inches.

There are a number of ways the blankets can be done: Knitted or crocheted in one continuous piece, or in strips and squares and then sewn or crocheted together-lots of possibilities.

The number of stitches in a continuous piece depends on type of yarn and tension, but as a general guide:

1. Cast on 20 stitches
2. Knit a few rows
3. Measure the width
4. Divide that number into 30
5. Then multiply that with the number of stitches.

For instance, if the 20 stitch piece is 4 inches wide, and 30 divided by 4 is 7.5, then 20 times 7.5 is 150 total stitches.

Needle size depends on the type of yarn. Suggested size will usually be given on the skein wrapper.

Knitted and Crocheted Baby Blankets

For instance, if the 20 stitch piece is 4 inches wide, and 30 divided by 4 is 7.5, then 20 times 7.5 is 150 total stitches.

Needle size depends on the type of yarn. Suggested size will usually be given on the skein wrapper.
