First Lutheran Church Council Highlights: January 9, 2023

<u>**Treasurer's Report:</u>** Financial reports were given to each council member. Denise presented a 2024 Budget similar to that of 2023, with a few minor changes that reflect actual expenditures for the year.</u>

Committee Reports:

- Music & Worship: discussed offer from Pastor Emmy to conduct Lenten worship and suggested changes to accompanist's new contract.
- **Property**: looking at additional quotes for window replacements; leak in roof will be looked at.

Old Business:

- Interim update: no new names given to us from Synod. Bishop Dee Pederson will be at First Lutheran on Sunday, February 25 to lead worship. Discussion was held on various options for Sunday worship and leaders.
- Benevolence for 2023 has been paid in full. A motion to send \$1800 a month starting in January was approved.
- 2024 Budget was approved for the Annual Meeting on Sunday, February 4 following the worship service.
- Names of those willing to serve on council were discussed and will be added to the Annual Meeting ballot.

New Business:

- Pastor Emmy from Faith Lutheran has offered to lead First and Faith combined midweek Lenten worship services. The Worship & Music Committee and the Council accepted this generous offer.
- Next council meeting will be on Tuesday, February 20 at 7:00pm.
