#### ThankOffering Collection

Beginning in the late 19th century, Lutheran women were given small ThankOffering boxes to place in a special location in their homes as a visible reminder of blessings received. Women would add coins to those boxes almost daily as particular blessings were noted. From their use came the idea of an annual church service to celebrate their collection, and so the women of the congregation would come together for a ThankOffering service.

At that first ThankOffering in 1889, \$6,100 was collected. Today, Women of the ELCA collects more than \$1 million in ThankOfferings annually for the ministries and mission of our women's organization. ThankOfferings have always been, and still are, our opportunity to say thank you to God in both significant and ordinary moments.

At First Lutheran Church, ThankOffering Collection containers are available in the Narthex. Please pick one up and collect your loose change. Money from this collection goes to support the life-changing ministries of the Women of the ELCA. We will collect the offering during worship on November 12, or they can be dropped off at the church office.

#### Fusion Student Ministry's Purpose and How we are accomplishing that purpose:

Engage – There is a need for this ministry to the youth and families of this community. The four churches involved have a little over 150 kids to pull from. Our goal is to engage youth both inside and outside the church walls!

In September – October Element: 56 students; Sr. High: 25 students; Parent Small Group: 5-8; Social Media & Website: Great way to engage the community and communicate what we are up to; Leadership: 17 adult volunteers & pastors & Student leadership: 4 students; Element Parent Meeting: 75 Parents/caregivers (roughly)

**Connect** – Having a sense of connection to others is so important at all ages, but especially during the 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> ages. We have a goal to help youth connect to other youth as well as to positive adults. We want to provide a safe environment for them to feel welcome, wanted and known. Love them where they are. Love is messy and the people we love are not perfect. Teenagers are certainly not perfect and in the messiness of life are looking for positive love and acceptance.

In small Group time and small group get togethers they are connected together, making friendships in a safe space and are connected to healthy adult leaders; Sr. High Lock-In & various fun activities helps to connect them through shared fun memories; & the Church without Walls porkchop lunch connected the youth and families to the church community!

**Teach** – Our goal is to teach youth to answer the question, "What do you believe about God and what does your life look like because of it?" This will be done through fun and creative teaching, experiences, connecting in small groups and letting them ask the hard questions.

We are teaching the Fruit of the Spirit Series in Element and Renew your Heart, Soul, Mind & Strength Series in Sr. High Fusion. The kids open their bibles, highlight in them, memorize bible verses and learn how to apply the truth of scripture to their daily life.

**Send** – Our goal is to send them out into the world with knowledge about God and how He relates to the world. Send them out to adventure and service. We want to make lifelong Christians who can love fiercely and respect others. Challenge them to live out their faith in all aspects of their life: at school, home, church, work and with friends and family.

We send our students and adults out into the world in so many ways. We sent out over 80 youth and adults on a prayer walk to pray for our community, churches, businesses & law enforcement (etc). We encourage our adult leadership to reach out to their students outside of Fusion. On Sat, Oct 14<sup>th</sup> a group of students and adults helped a family in Benson move into their home. And we are training future leaders: Piper Swanson, who is our Sr High Fusion Intern wants to be a youth pastor in the future and is leading in the Sr. High Fusion area! And students in student Leadership in Sr. High Fusion are stepping up to the plate to help lead and plan!
