If this results in a positive experience and our congregation decides to move forward with further collaboration, the two councils and Pastor Matt would continue discussing and prayerfully planning a path forward.

Throughout the summer, the council will also stay in contact with Faith Lutheran to gauge interest in possible collaboration.
