Hello, First Family,

In his preaching and teaching, Jesus often used metaphors and figurative language in order to help the people relate to what he was saying. When speaking of the mission field in Matthew 9, Jesus said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest."

The concept of harvest is very important to the Jewish people. The Feast of the Tabernacles is a Jewish holiday held in the fall to celebrate the harvest, as well as the Israelites' exodus from Egypt. This year it is from Monday, October 6—Monday, October 13. The Feast of the Tabernacles is one of three Pilgrimage Festivals—a festival whereby the Jews traditionally traveled to the Temple in Jerusalem—along with Passover and the Feast of Weeks.

We can relate to the concept of harvest as well. It is the time of year once again where the farmers are working hard in their fields to gather the crops that will provide for so many. As the farmers labor in their fields this harvest season, Jesus calls us to labor as well. He tells us that the mission field is ripe for harvest. There are so many ways to do this work. We can harvest God's mission field here in Morris by loving our neighbors as ourselves, by sharing our faith, by helping and caring for those in need.

While harvest occurs just once a year, we are called to harvest the mission field all year long. And while we celebrate a harvest season just once a year, we experience the spirit of harvest all of the time. We experience harvest when we receive love from family, when we enjoy time with friends, when we earn a paycheck, when we feel close to God. And the harvests we experience daily do not belong to us, but to God, because God is the Lord of the harvest.

ThankOffering Collection

Beginning in the late 19th century, Lutheran women were given small Beginning in the late 19th century, Lutheran women were given small Thank Offering boxes to place in a special location in their homes as a visible reminder of blessings received. Women would add coins to those boxes almost daily as particular blessings were noted. From their use came the idea of an annual church service to celebrate their collection, and so the women of the congregation would come together for a ThankOffering service.

At that first ThankOffering in 1889, \$6,100 was collected. Today, Women of the ELCA collects more than \$1 million in ThankOfferings annually for the ministries and mission of our women's organization. ThankOfferings have always been, and still are, our opportunity to say thank you to God in both significant and ordinary moments.

At First Lutheran Church, ThankOffering Collection containers are available in the Narthex. Please pick one up and collect your loose change. Money from this collection goes to support the life-changing ministries of the Women of the ELCA. We will collect the offering at church on November 23, or they can be dropped off at the church office.

LUTHERAN WORLD RELIEF & GLOBAL HEALTH MINISTRIES KIT PACKING. On September 7, our Sunday School students packed 30 newborn kits for Global Health Ministries , 64 Personal Care Kits and 40 School its for Lutheran World Relief. Our First Lutheran Church Endowment funds are used to purchase supplies for kits. Thank you to those who donated school kit items and newborn kit supplies. Dental Depot and Morris Dental donated toothbrushes and The Homestead gave us a discount on towels and combs for the personal care kits. The Sunday School students also assembled Water filtration kits provided through the Thrivent Cause program and we assembled some additional birthday bags for the Stevens County Food Shelf.

Those who attended the lunch following our Church Without Walls morning activities donated \$140 towards shipping the kits packed. That amount along with endowment money not spent on kit supplies was divided and we were able to send \$128 to Global Health Ministries and \$128 to Lutheran World Relief.
