A Time to Pray...

Lent will have begun by the time you read this. By way of reminder, Lent means “spring.” And it hints at ‘new life’ around the corner.

Are the doldrums of winter getting the best of you? Does the repetitiveness of each day appeal to you, or repel you? As winter lingers on, and may lead to a low-spirited moods, or “I don’t want to get out of bed day” – what does our faith summon us toward?

Prayer may be an important part of your life or not. Meanwhile, we will be exploring prayer during this season of Lent. During worship, we have a “Prayer of the Day” which focuses us on the theme of the Scriptures; and Prayers of Intercession: prayers for the world, everyone in it, Christians and non-Christians, and the needs of many.

Meanwhile, in our daily lives, *where our faith is lived out*, prayer – communion with God – can be a blessing that opens us to God’s eternal perspective and light. It has been said, prayer is a workshop, for faith – and the faithful. It’s not something that has to be “one more thing” on your daily list. “Prayer” can take place as you’re dropping your kids off at school, while you’re watching the sunrise (or set), in the morning, with a cup of coffee, a random reading of the Bible, or in the midst of a chaotic day. It may be the best way to start your morning (that’s been my discovery). And the Apostle Paul urges us “pray without ceasing” (I Thessalonians 5: 17). Maybe he means be open to God – the Holy – at any and all times? For God may be nearer than we realize.

Prayer is really communion with God. The God who loves us *more than we love ourselves*, comes to us without our request, yet, when we pray, we open ourselves to the mystery of encounter with the Holy, and Holy One. I find that the Bible makes more sense when I pray as I read. I hope that this Lenten season can be a springtime for our lives and souls, “in the school of prayer.” A simple “thank you, God!” or “Help!” are as valid prayers as the most articulate prayer. This Lent, we’ll explore prayer during Sunday morning adult study and during our midweek services, hearing the perspectives of different pastors.

Jesus prayed, he taught his disciples the great prayer, and he invites us into a prayer relationship.

“Now to him who by the power at work within us is able to accomplish abundantly far more than all we can ask or imagine, to him be glory in the church and in Jesus Christ to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.” —Ephesians 3: 20-2





Personal Care Kits: • 1 light-weight bath-size towel (between 20x40" and 52x27") dark color recommended • 2 or 3 bath-size bars of soap equaling 8-9 oz., any brand (in original wrapping) • 1 adult-size toothbrush (in original packaging) • 1 sturdy comb • 1 metal nail clippers

Baby Care Kits: • 2 lightweight cotton t-shirts (no Onesies®) • 2 long or short-sleeved gowns or sleepers (without feet) • 2 receiving blankets, medium-weight cotton or flannel, or crocheted or knitted with lightweight yarn, between 36x36" and 52x52" • 4 cloth diapers, flat fold preferred • jacket, sweater or sweatshirt with a hood, or include a baby cap • 2 pairs of socks • 1 hand towel, dark color recommended • 2 or 3 bath-size bars of gentle soap equaling 8-9 oz., any brand, in original wrapping (no mini or hotel size bars) • 2 diaper pins or large safety pins.
