Rich Reflections

Friends in Christ,

We've spent a good bit of July and August feasting on, and digesting, John 6 "the Bread of Life" and the Letter to the Ephesians which reminds us how amazing and abundant God's love is and how we can life out our faith in love and peace with fellow believers and in the world.

We are looking forward to a full and fruitful fall here at First Lutheran. September 8th we'll be having "Church Without Walls", going out to serve our neighbors and joining together for fellowship at the end. Then we'll have Rally Sunday on the 15th to mark the beginning of Sunday School, Element and our program year.

In September and October, we will be taking some time in worship for some conversations. Yes, talking with each other in worship! Sharing stories of the past, and envisioning what God is calling us to in the future. We'll keep it relatively simple and safe.

"Coming to Terms with History" is one of the steps to get ready for a new pastor and a new season in the life of the church. Every congregation has stories. When anniversaries are celebrated the stories focus on success and joy. That's good and appropriate. But we know there are shortcomings, grief and maybe even some lingering hurt. We don't want to get stuck there, but we can gain vital wisdom from those difficult moments or seasons.

"Discovering a New Identity" can be energizing and life-giving. One the one hand, both Malachi 3:6 and Hebrews 13:8 declare that *God* is the *same* always and never ever changes. Is God then, and the church, stale and stagnant? Hardly! When we look at the Bible as a whole, we see that God keeps starting over. Noah and his family is a new beginning. In Abraham and Sarah establishes a covenant. With Moses, Miriam and Aaron God starts over with another covenant. In King David God makes another new start that is ultimately fulfilled in the birth of Jesus. And in between God promises a new covenant through Jeremiah and Ezekiel—to bring them out of captivity. God IS the same... and that sameness is about always doing something new!

"Renewing Connections" beyond the congregation, is vital and important in moving forward. Sometimes we take our associations with others for granted. This congregation has done ministry and made a difference in this local community. First Lutheran's influence goes across the Southwestern Minnesota Synod. Our reach and support touch lives across this country. The love and generosity of this local church is felt around the world. That may sound like an overstatement. However, we need to keep reminding ourselves of the stories and relationships that we have far and wide, as well as near and dear.

"Commitment to a New Direction" is challenging, but it's necessary and essential. I love to go sailing. Over the years I've learned that when the wind changes direction, you need to change the set of your sails. And when you are facing a headwind to get to your desired destination, you must keep "tacking", going back and forth facing part way into the breeze but still moving forward. I don't know for sure where God what new compass heading or direction God is calling us to. However, I do know that if we will venture out God will provide a way to get there.

Certainly all that will make for some joyful and energizing times here at First.


