

Hello, First Family,

Happy New Year! This is the final Calvin and Hobbes comic strip by cartoonist Bill Watterson. It was published on December 31, 1995. In the first panel, we see Calvin and Hobbes trekking through new-fallen snow. Hobbes is carrying a toboggan, and Calvin says, "Wow, it really snowed last night! Isn't it wonderful?"

In the next panel, we find Hobbes smiling and saying, "Everything familiar has disappeared! The world looks brand-new." Calvin then says, "A new year...a fresh, clean start!" This comic of a fresh snowfall is a wonderful illustration of the clean start and many possibilities that come with a new year.

As a new year begins, let us remember that in Christ we are given a new life day after day. Through the grace of God, we have an opportunity to begin again every day as a new creation, forgiven and loved by God. The Apostle Paul tells us that "we have been buried with Christ by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life" (Rom. 6:4).

Continuing on in the comic, Hobbes says about the new snow, "It's like having a big white sheet of paper to draw on!" Calvin then says, "A day full of possibilities!" I believe that 2026 is full of possibilities. I would invite you to take a sheet of paper of your own. Write the possibilities you see for yourself, your family, First and the community in the year ahead. Add to the list when you think of more ideas. If and when you wish, share your list with your family and friends.

Working together as the body of Christ, and with the help of the Holy Spirit, there are many possibilities and much to explore in 2026. And so, as Calvin says to Hobbes as they go sliding down the hill, I say to you "...Let's go exploring!"

CHRISTMAS GREETING FROM MICHAEL & CARMEN ZOUGHBI

Christmas time is here, and everyone rejoices! Let us celebrate the birth of Jesus, the Son of God. Through His coming into the world, He gave us the promise of a new and abundant life. The shepherds received the joyful announcement of His birth, and a great multitude of angels sang, "Today the Savior is born!" 
